

2. Johann Heinrich Diehl, Vacation Pass, 1842

[Translation:]

Vacation Pass

Presenter of this, the Musketeer Johann Heinrich Diehl,
from the 8th Company of the Royal Prussian 35th Infantry Regiment/3rd Reserve/ from Würgendorf in Siegen County of the administrative
5 district Arnsberg. 5 foot 6 inches tall, with slim physique
and brown hair, who was born on the 18th of May 1817 and
who arrived for active military service on December 1st 1839.
And who consequently has achieved an active service time of 3 years and zero months,
10 is released for non-specified vacation to Würgendorf in the county of Siegen
of the administrative district of Arnsberg and if not recalled
to the flags of the standing army, crosses over to the first contingent of the
state army on December 1st 1844. After his arrival
at his chosen destination, he must report this to the sergeant of that
administrative district's army and show this vacation pass as well as for possible
15 residential changes and for future trips the report of this pass should be
repeated each time. The district may be left only when this report is first shown
to the sergeant of the district being vacated and to the sergeant of the district
in which the new residence is documented.

The musketeer Diehl received the following premiums during target practice.

20 A special certificate was given to the same [Musketeer Diehl] about his conduct.
Due to skills acquired through service as well as his previous good behavior he is given the
evaluation that he would be suited for corporal in the future.

30 one forage cap

(enough for the march)

The same (Musketeer Diehl) is also supplied
with provisions until the 2nd of December 1842.

35 In regard to the munitions, is settled
according to regulation.
