Chicago Ill August 29-93 Dear Mary We wanted to go to St. Joseph 5 This morning on the Lake Michigan. But it was such a storm on the Lake that we was afraid to go so we have bin around 10 all day in Chicago and seeing sights we was to the Aditorum Mussium<sup>1</sup> and to Amors pacing house<sup>2</sup> and to the Olimagarine<sup>3</sup> factory and to Bufflo Bills 15 show. To morrow morning if nothing hapens we will

- there. We have a notion that we will send our Satchel home by Express so that we
