Chicago Ill  
August 29-93  
Dear Mary  
We wanted to go to St. Joseph  
5 This morning on the Lake  
Michigan. But it was  
such a storm on the Lake  
that we was afraid to  
go so we have bin around  
10 all day in Chicago and  
seeing sights we was to  
the Aditorum Mussium<sup>1</sup> and  
to Amors pacing house<sup>2</sup>  
and to the Olimagarine<sup>3</sup>  
15 factory and to Bufflo Bills  
show. To morrow morning  
if nothing hapens we will  
take the Steamer to St.  
Joseph. And I will write  
20 you as soon as we git  
there. We have a notion  
that we will send  
our Satchel home  
by Express so that we  
25 don't have to cary it  
around with us. Now  
I will adress it to  
Charles Goetsch and  
you can git it from  
30 him and take it home  
if Nothing hapens I  
think we will be  
home Saturday If not  
I will let you know.

with our ticket in  
Milwaukee I will let
