and money order from Juneau and also received  
the letter Sarah wrote + the picturs.  
The money came just in time I just had  
90¢ left. I am going stockjudgeing this afternoon  
10 and when I am throug I will go up to the  
post office and cash my order and also get  
me some caugh remidy. I have had a cald  
for two weeks.  
I have also a new boarding place  
15 again. The place at Mrs. Rowe where I was  
last that was a club boarding place. The  
dairy boys left Thursday noon and so that  
broke up the club. I only paid \$2.01 at the  
club for board per week The place I and  
20 Koch board now is on Julia St. about two  
blocks away from where I room must pay \$2.50  
per week. This is my 4th boarding place in  
Madison.  
I received a letter from Clara Krause  
25 yesterday.  
Streets are very muddy here snow  
mostly gone.  
I think we will have no school  
Monday it is Washingtons birthday  
30 Now I must stop and judge a  
hog at the farm  
Answer soon again
