Oct.18.1906

Dear brother:

I received your letter, and
5 seen from it, that you allways have
lots of company. Last Sunday
afternoon, Henry got one from Cresco.
Monday and Tuesday uncle Amel
thrashed, 14 hundred bushel grain,
10 and 100 bushel thymoty¹ seed.
Yesterday I sewed at John Bigalks
This morning it rained here. it
is clearing up now, and so uncle
Amel, aunt Tina and I want
15 to go to uncle Wm, and see
his new barn. If it is good
weather Saturday. then Goerge
Volkman wants to go to the
Prairie. he will take the double
20 carriage. I don't know yet who
else will go besides me. I will
write you a letter soon. Hope you
are all well. Your sister Sarah.
