Sheboygan Wis., Nov. 12. – 1899

Dear parents and brother:

We have been waiting for
a letter from you, but
5 we thought you would visit
us soon with winter
Could you visit us all?
Now the trip doesn't cost
as much for everyone as to
10 Sauk for one. At first we
thought we would visit you
on Thanksgiving day, but the
time is so short we could come
first on Thursday and then
15 would have to leave again on Monday
Maybe we could come right after Christmas
during the vacation. Oscar and Edna
go to school every day.
Could you not come for
20 Thanksgiving day.

gathering. Uncle Gustav
